THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

The author of Hebrews exhorts us to heed the gospel message, encourages us remain faithful when we are fainthearted, and reminds us to glory in Christ who tasted death for our salvation.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION *(Use along with **Reading: Ante Faciem Dei**)*

- Why does the author of Hebrews warn believers to not “drift away?”
- What is the “message we have heard” (verse 1, 2)? How has it been delivered and verified?
- What is presently distracting you from the gospel and is, therefore, causing you to “drift away” from Christ?
- Discuss how the title “son of man” is both a reference to humans and Jesus Christ.
- What does it mean that Jesus was made “lower than the angels” (verse 9)? How was his death unlike the death of any other person?
