Scripture: Hebrews 3:6-19



THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

The author of Hebrews exhorts us to examine our hearts; root out any evil, unbelief; and hold fast to our confidence in the sufficiency of Christ's saving work.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION *(Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)*

- Why do we often ignore warning signs in our life and cling so tightly to the sins that are hurting and slowly destroying us?
- What is the Exodus story and why is it still relevant to us today?
- What is the point of the three rhetorical questions posed in verses 16-18?
- Are you regularly examining your heart and keeping watch over your thoughts, desires, affections?
- Are you involved in an atmosphere of encouragement – a gospel-centered community of mutual accountability and edification? Why is this important?
- Ask the following questions of yourself and consider whether you are hardening your heart against the living God.
 - *Do you go hours, days, or even weeks without acknowledging God's glory and Christ's lordship over your life?*
 - *Is your sorrow over sin motivated by what others think rather than about what God thinks?*
 - *Is the idea of fellowshiping with other believers or corporate worship unappealing to you?*
 - *Are you overly critical of others' faults rather than pursuing holiness in your own life?*
