- Why does it matter whether or not we mature in the faith (Ephesians 4:14)? Do you have an eagerness to learn the deeper things of God or have you become sluggish, unreceptive, or disinterested?
- What does it look like to have a childlike faith and yet be mature in the faith at the same time?
- What are you doing to make every effort to progress in your walk with God? Are you making a commitment to gather in gospel-centered community, the fertile soil of optimal spiritual growth?
