- Ultimately, where does the strength, joy, and thanksgiving to endure God's discipline come from?
- What are the marks of those who run the race of faith?
- How do we balance between striving for peace and people-pleasing?
- Are you encouraging yourself and others to "obtain the grace of God"? How?
- What are the two fleshly appetites that can tempt us to abandon Christ?
- What's the difference between tearful regret as illustrated by Esau and genuine repentance?
- What are the two mountains that the author contrasts in verses 18-21? What do they represent?
- How does Jesus' shed blood speak a better word than Abel?
