THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

In this closing chapter of his letter, the author of Hebrews exhorts us to love God and our neighbor, remember the grace of God, and cling to Jesus Christ.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION *(Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)*

- What are some ways the author exhorts his readers (and us) to love our spiritual family? Who is the Holy Spirit specifically leading you to love better?
- How and why do we should we hold marriage in honor?
- Explain how contentment is a heart issue. How do we experience true, lasting contentment? How does contentment affect our love for God and others? How does contentment eradicate fear?
- What was tempting the original readers away from grace? What does the enemy use to tempt you to forget the grace of God in Jesus Christ?
- What point is the author making by contrasting the uneatable sacrificial meat with Jesus' self-sacrifice? What holy day is the author referencing (Leviticus 16)? Why is it significant that Jesus suffered "outside the gate" of Jerusalem? How do we bear the reproach he endured outside the camp?
