

## Sunday Morning Health and Safety Guidelines

In cooperation with the CDC's COVID-19 recommended preventative practices, we have developed the following guidelines for the protection and safety of all those who visit King's Chapel for Corporate Worship. By attending the service or allowing your child(ren) to attend Children's Church, you acknowledge that you have read and agree to comply with these safeguards while in attendance. *We advise those who have been in contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case, those who are sick or have fevers, and the elderly and high-risk population who have serious underlying health conditions to stay home and join our service livestream.* 

## **Corporate Worship**

- All attendees must honor the 6-feet social distancing guidelines while in the building and on King's Chapel property.
- While in the building, adults are required to wear face coverings when they are not seated.
- We advise those who wish to fellowship before or after service to do so outdoors where proper social distancing can be maintained.
- Weather permitting, we will gather in the backyard for service. Please bring a lawn chair.
- Multiple hand sanitizer stations are stationed throughout the church, including at all designated entrances and exits.
- All church staff and volunteers will be temperature checked upon arrival. Any volunteers with a fever or showing signs of sickness will be sent home.
- We recommend that all attendees check their temperature before arrival. Please stay home if you have a fever, cough, or don't feel well.
- We advise against making any form of physical contact with other attendees, including shaking hands, hugging, etc.
- The doors to the main entrance will remain propped open before and immediately following the service.
- We have reduced the seating capacity and restructured the seating layout in the Gathering Space to create adequate space for maintaining social distancing guidelines.
- Weather permitting, all windows in the Gathering Space will remain open for the duration of the service
- Rather than passing tithes/offering baskets, we have stationed them in the Foyer.
- Individual, pre-packaged communion elements will be distributed by volunteers wearing masks and gloves.
- We have suspended the use of bulletins.

- (Outdoor Services) Volunteers wearing masks and gloves will distribute printed song lyric sheets.
- Restrooms will function as single-occupancy and have been outfitted with automated, touch-free soap and paper towel dispensers as well as sanitizing wipes. We advise all those who frequent the restrooms to wash their hands thoroughly and wipe down affected areas with the provided sanitizing wipes immediately after use.
- Attendees should use the one-way traffic patterns established in the Gathering Space, as indicated by taped arrows.
- The Information Table will be temporarily closed. All information and signups are available on our website.
- In place of the water cooler, we have prepared a bottled water station. No other refreshments such as coffee, tea, or food will be provided.
- Classroom 105 is designated as a quarantine area for those who show signs of sickness.
- Unused rooms and doors will remain closed at all times.
- Lidless trash cans will be used throughout the building.

## Nursery & Children's Church

- We are offering childcare for Nursery age children (0-3years old) and a Children's Church program for children ages PreK through 2nd Grade. We advise parents to keep their older children with them at all times before, during, and after the service.
- All volunteers, including Nursery attendants and Children's Church Volunteers, will be temperature checked upon arrival. Any volunteers with a fever or showing signs of sickness will be sent home.
- Nursery attendants and Children's Church volunteers are required to wear masks while indoors.
- Children's Church teachers are permitted to remove masks while teaching the Bible lesson as long as they can maintain appropriate social distancing.
- Children's Church volunteers will ensure that all children sanitize their hands upon arrival and dismissal from Children's Church.
- Children's Church volunteers will do their best to ensure that children do not share objects.
- When necessary, classroom helpers will assist children to the bathroom and ensure that children practice thorough handwashing before returning to class.
- No snacks will be served in the Nursery or during Children's Church.
- Children are **not required** to wear masks and are permitted to have some interaction with one another, which may include playing outdoors on the playground.
