Financially support gospel ministry is an act of worship through which we joyfully share in the plentiful harvest and experience the pleasure of our God.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- How had the Philippian church shared in Paul's gospel ministry? What was the fruit that followed from the church's financial support?
- Are you sharing in the gospel harvest by financially supporting gospel ministry? Have you experienced the camaraderie that flows from gospel partnership?
- Why do we often shy away from talking about money? Explain how we use our money reveals what we treasure.
- What is the credit that Paul is referring to in verse 17 (Luke 12:32)? How does it compare to earthly credit? How do we expand our heavenly account?
- Read Paul's account of the Philippian church in 2 Corinthians 8:1-5. What was the Philippians' motive for giving? What is your motive for giving?
- Explain how giving is an act of worship. How does God respond to our faithful worship through generously giving (verse 18)?
- What does the gospel teach us about the degree of Jesus' generosity (2 Corinthians 8:9)?
- How is verse 19 frequently misapplied or taken out of context? What's the proper context of this verse? To whom does this promise apply?
- What riches do Jesus makes available to those who generously give?
- Can you testify of how God has graciously supplied your needs? Is the Holy Spirit leading you to give more generously to gospel ministry?
