Scripture: Colossians 1:1-2



THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

Paul opens his letter asserting his apostolic authority, affirming the faithfulness of the Colossian believers, and announcing God's grace and peace upon the church at Colossae.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- How does the reality of Christ's supremely and sufficiency practically impact your life (decisions, feelings, thoughts, plans, etc.)?
- How does it protect from false gospels, religions, and vain human philosophy?
- What was Epaphras' role in the church at Colossae (verse 7)? What do we know about Timothy?
- What's the primary reason Paul wrote the letter to the Colossians (2:8)? How were false teachers distorting the gospel and redefining faith in Jesus Christ?
- Who is Paul, what was his role as an apostle of Jesus Christ, and how was he commissioned?
- Discuss how Scripture is the authority over the church today.
- What qualifies someone as a "saint and faithful brother and sister" (verses 2a, 13-14)? What is Paul's greeting, and how does it point to the powerful work of Christ (verse 2b)?
- Share why you believe the book of Colossians is still relevant today.
