Sunday, June 20, 2021 Scripture: Isaiah 25



THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

The dominant theme of Isaiah 25-27 is of God triumphing over his enemies and saving his people.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- How does Isaiah address God at the opening of chapter 25? What are the four reasons that Isaiah praises God (verses 1-5)? How much more reason do we have to worship God and exalt Christ (Ephesians 1)?
- What does the metaphor of storms reveal about God (verse 4-5)?
- Do you praise God for *who* He is, what He *has done*, and what He *will do*?
- What does the fabulous feast signify (verse 6)? Who will enjoy this feast, and when will this banquet take place (Matthew 26)?
- What four mighty acts will God perform (verses 7-8)? What is the covering and veil that will God remove? Why must death be destroyed? Discuss how these blessings come through the cross of Christ and not through human effort.
- Why will Moab receive God's judgment? What can we learn from their humiliation?
