## THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

Judah sings a song of exaltation and praise to God for who He, what He has done, and what He will accomplish in the future.

## QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION *(Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)*

- What do verses 1-6 teach us about God and the salvation he supplies?
- What nations are permitted to enter the city gates, and what is their passport (verse 2)?
- Is your mind preoccupied with worry, or is it set on Christ?
- What happens when the gates of salvation are opened to the nations (verses 5-6)?
- How does God level the way of the righteous? What does it mean to actively wait on God?
- How do God's judgments (discipline) teach us righteousness (verses 9-10)?
- How do unrepentant rebels interpret God's grace and mercy (verse 10-11), and what is their destiny?
- What works of God are revealed and celebrated in verses 12-15?
- What comes from prideful self-confidence and self-justification (verses 17-18)?
- What glorious promise is revealed amidst Judah's distress (Verse 19)?
- What does God graciously command his people to do in verses 20-21? Why? How can anyone be shielded from God's righteous fury?
- What is Isaiah illustrating by referencing God's destruction of the mythological creature Leviathan (27:1)?
