Community Group Discussion Guide

Sunday, October 1, 2023 Scripture: Luke 10:1-24



THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

Jesus commissions 72 disciples to announce the immanent Kingdom of God, provides, protects, empowers them on their mission, and rejoices with their return.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- What task did Jesus give his 72 disciples (verses 1-2), and why did he send them in pairs? What's significant about the number of disciples that Jesus commissioned (Genesis 10)?
- Do you prioritize prayer in evangelism? Do you believe God is sovereign over the means and ends of salvation (Acts 18)?
- While living as "lambs among wolves," how do we avoid being overwhelmed by fear or the stress of being empty-handed (verses 3-4)? Do you find it difficult to depend on others for help and resources?
- Share some principles we can learn from the descriptions of this historic event.
- Why did Jesus instill within the disciples the power to heal (verse 9)? Does God continue to work miracles today? Discuss the importance of both *demonstrating* and *declaring* the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- Why is the gospel of Christ offensive to the world? How did Jesus instruct the disciples to respond to rejection?
- What warning and examples does he give them? Why will some experience a harsher degree of judgment before God's throne? What is the inevitable consequence of rejecting Jesus' message (Verse 16)?
- Do you feel the weightiness of other's eternal destinies?
- How did the disciples respond when they returned from their expedition? How did Jesus redirect their joy (verse 20)? Why did Jesus rejoice (verses 21-24)?
- Based on this passage, why can we be simultaneously humble and confident that the church will succeed in her mission?
