QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. How was Jesus treated during his ministry in Bethany (verse 38)?
- 2. What can we glean about Martha and Mary from this passage and other Scripture passages?
- 3. With which sister do you most identify: Martha or Mary? Why?
- 4. What would have been considered culturally taboo about Jesus' interaction with the sisters?
- 5. What did it mean to sit at Jesus' feet? What does that mean today?
- 6. Was Martha wrong to show hospitality? How had her good service been corrupted?
- 7. What has replaced the joy you once experienced through serving Jesus (doubt, anxiety, self-importance, self-pity, bitterness, disappointment, etc.)? Like Martha, have the cares and busyness of life distracted from the life-giving, worship-producing Word of God?
- 8. How did Jesus lovingly correct Martha (verse 41)? What is he commending about Mary's choice (verse 42)?
- 9. Read John 11:17-26. What remarkable change do we see in Martha, and what can we learn from her?
