THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

Jesus delivers a woman from a disabling spirit on the Sabbath, rebukes the religious for their hypocrisy, and reveals the bourgeoning Kingdom of God.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. What can we learn about the person and work of Jesus from this text?
- 2. What cultural and religious boundaries did Jesus overcome to show this woman compassion? What can we learn from her response to Jesus' healing (verses 13 and 17)?
- 3. Have you experienced Jesus' compassion and his power to save? What does it mean to glorify God, and how do we praise God with our lives?
- 4. Can God physically heal today? What is our comfort when we don't experience the healing we desire?
- 5. Why was the ruler angry about the miracle (verse 14)? What is the Sabbath, and what "law" did Jesus break?
- 6. Why did Jesus call the religious leaders hypocrites (verse 15)?
- 7. Does criticism prevent you from showing compassion to others? How do we avoid making silly rules that distract us from the mission to make disciples?
- 8. What is the point of Jesus' parables in verses 18-21? How does this woman's healing highlight the kingdom of God?
