Scripture: Luke 13:31-35



THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

Jesus is a compassionate Savior who remained resolute and steadfast in His mission to save sinners.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. How does this week's text connect with the previous verses from the chapter?
- 2. Who was Herod, and why did he want to kill Jesus (Matthew 14:2)? Why do you think the Pharisees, who were Jesus' adversaries, warned him?
- 3. Why did Jesus refer to Herod as a fox (verse 32)? With the threat of death, why could Jesus confidently say that he would finish his course (John 10:18)?
- 4. Discuss how the reality of God's sovereignty is a source of comfort for the believer, especially in times of fear, suffering, and persecution.
- 5. Why were prophets unsafe in Jerusalem during Israel's history (verse 33)? Why "must" Jesus fulfill his plans (Hebrews 10:7; Luke 9:22)?
- 6. Why did Jesus lament over Jerusalem (verses 34-35)? What does the imagery of hen's wings reveal about Jesus' heart toward sinners (Psalm 61:4; 91:4; Ruth 2:12)?
- 7. What is Jesus' warning to the unrepentant, and when was this prophecy fulfilled (verse 35; Luke 19:41-44)? What will Jesus' return evoke from all people (verse 35; Psalm 118:26; Romans 14:11-12; Phil 2:10-11; Revelation 1:7)?
- 8. Discuss how the gospel fuels our passion to live on mission.
