## THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

Jesus teaches that following him means renouncing all that stands in the way of living in faith and submission to his Lordship.

## QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. What is the cost of being Jesus' disciple (verses 26-27)? How do we demonstrate a love for others, things, and self over Jesus Christ?
- 2. How do we ensure that the loves in our lives are well-ordered?
- 3. What does Jesus mean to bear one's cross (verse 27)? How is this typically misunderstood?
- 4. What's preventing you from experiencing the life-giving joy that accompanies following Jesus (fear, regrets, attachments, etc.)?
- 5. What principle is Jesus communicating with his illustrations in verses 27-32? What practical steps can you take to kill sin and remove the obstacles preventing you from treasuring Jesus?
- 6. What is Jesus' warning with his illustration of salt in verses 33-35?
- 7. Why should we love Jesus above all else (Romans 5:8-10)? How does the gospel increase our love and devotion to Jesus Christ?
