THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

We cannot justify ourselves before God by keeping his law nor by disregarding it; instead, we must accept God's grace and forgiveness granted to us through Jesus Christ.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. Who were the Pharisees, and what was their position and influence in society? What did Jesus say that incited their ridicule (verse 14)?
- 2. "Religion can be highly profitable;" why is that? Where do we see signs of that today?
- 3. How did the Pharisees attempt to justify themselves? How do we do the same, and why?
- 4. What does this passage teach us about God and ourselves?
- 5. According to verse 15, what does God consider an abomination?
- 6. Who was John the Baptis,t and what was his unique role in God's redemptive plan (verse 16a)? What has changed with John's passing and Jesus' arrival (verse 16b)?
- 7. How should we respond to the inauguration of the kingdom of God? What does it mean that "everyone forces his way into it [kingdom of God]" (verse 16)?
- 8. What does verse 17 teach us about God's Word? Discuss how God's law is still binding on followers of Jesus today.
- 9. How had the Pharisees undermined the law that they claimed to uphold (verse 18; Deuteronomy 24:1)?
- 10. Discuss how the gospel remedies our attempts at self-justification.
