Scripture: Luke 5:1-11



THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

Jesus demonstrated his authority and power through his teaching, validated by his miraculous works, and he calls people to follow him.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- Why did crowds gather to Jesus (verse 1)? What was he teaching (4:42-44)?
- What is a disciple? Why is listening to the voice of Jesus vital to discipleship?
- What did Jesus instruct Simon Peter and the other fishermen? What assurance came with his command?
- How did Peter respond? Are there areas of your life that you've "mastered" but have not submitted to Jesus' authority?
- What did Jesus teach by his miraculous work?
- How does Peter address Jesus after the miraculous catch, and what can we learn from his confession?
- What's the appropriate response to Jesus' holiness (Isaiah 6)? Discuss how the gravity of sin and the holiness of God, viewed in light of the cross, propels us toward God.
- What does it mean for us to be fishermen of people (verse 10; Mark 1:17)?
- List some people within your spheres of influence who need to hear the gospel.
- Are you neglecting Jesus' call to make disciples? If so, why?
- Discuss the following aspects of disciple-making:
 - Be intentional
 - o Be willing to work at it
 - o Rely on God to change hearts (1 Corinthians 3:5-7)
 - o Rest in God's sovereignty and the Spirit's power (Acts 18:9-11)
