- What are passions and worldly systems that we should oppose (verse 12)?

- How does the blessed hope practically impact our daily lives? What is the difference between worldly hope and biblical hope (2 Corinthians 4:4-6)?
- According to verse 14, how has Jesus saved us? How does this change our relationship with God and the way we live?
- What areas of your life need training in the gospel of God's grace?
