## QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. Why did the young ruler address Jesus the way he did? How did Jesus redirect him? Do you believe God is good?
- 2. Based on his conversation with Jesus, how did this man define sin? How does Jesus correct him with his response?
- 3. What was the perception of wealth and the wealthy in Jesus' day? If riches and achievements cannot guarantee salvation, how can a sinner be made right with God?
- 4. What is idolatry and how can we identify the idols in our lives?
- 5. Why did the rich young ruler leave his conversation with Jesus sorrowful? What's the difference between worldly and godly grief (2 Corinthians 7:8-9)?
- 6. What prompted Peter's statement (verse 28)? What are the present and future benefits Jesus promised for those who sacrifice their lives for Christ?
- 7. What does this text teach us about God?
- 8. Like Jesus, how can we approach others with the truth of the gospel in love (Mark 10:21)?
